### Our Impact

Ascensa Health played a transformative role in the lives of 861 individuals supporting their journey to recovery.

**44%** were homeless upon admission to our program

**24%** were served in our federal probation program

**44%** of individuals in the residential program entered employment services

**62%** exited our residential program to housing

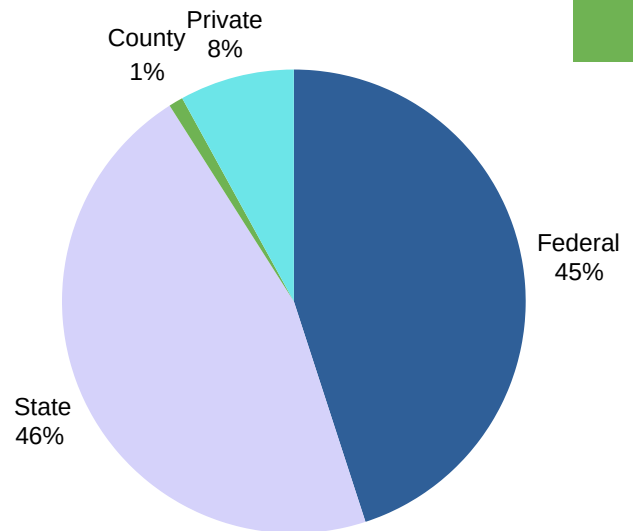
**87%** of those individuals completed treatment
